Sourced from our hillside planting at the Happy Canyon vineyard in the Santa Ynez Valley.

Once pressed, the juice is then tank fermented using only native yeast. We then transfer to neutral oak barrels for the winter to help build texture. The wine is then racked back to a stainless tank prior to bottling in the spring resulting in a fresh, mouthwatering wine.

Who in the world understands Chenin Blanc? This grape variety, with its origins most notably from the Loire Valley, is often simultaneously subtle and wild. The 2016 Lieu Dit is bone dry and active on the palate. **TASTING NOTES:** This wine is racy and biting. Its aromas and flavors of dried pear skin, chalk, and minerality should pair it well with lime-accented ceviche. (Tasted: March 16, 2018, San Francisco, CA)
