Vinification Fermentation and maceration in

> stainless steel tanks for three weeks. The wine is aged for twelve months followed by barriques, additional eighteen months

aging in large oak casks.

Characteristics Nebbiolo completely reflects the

> characteristics of the Cereguio terroir. Conteisa has an intense nose, balsamic, sweet and ripe with notes of plum, blackberry, tar and spices; sumptuous texture; full body with concentrated fruit and very accessible character due to the perfect balance between aromas and the other components of the

wine.
