CHARACTER

Confound it! Delightfully good. With the comfort of the throbbing, smoky, warm-hearted voice and charisma of Hildegard Knef, the essence of the naked rosé is distant from the kitsch of its superficial rosé sisters. Packed with fruit, brilliant and straightforward yet with lascivious curves, “not to be alone and yet to be free” should be the motto that allows this wine to rain red roses for you. Together with bright red berried, honest fruit and a persistent, dry aftertaste, the 2020 naked rosé celebrates the sheer beauty of shared conviviality that provides satisfaction in the great joy of the supposedly, small things. Simply and touchingly, a good drink.

ORIGIN

This Blaufränkisch grows in vineyards on slopes of the Leitha Mountains in Winden and Breitenbrunn that face southeast toward Lake Neusiedl and are distinguished by the typical, regional fossil-rich limestone, calcareous sandstone and mica schist.

GENESIS

Bottled with conscientious handcraft and great care throughout the entire life cycle. Organic and biodynamic cultivation of the vineyards. Handpicked mid-September, partial whole bunch press ranging from immediate press to a few hours' maceration, spontaneous alcoholic and malolactic fermentation. 5 months maturation on its natural yeast lees in amphorae. Bottled unfiltered with minimal sulphur.
