Petit Paveil, 2nd wine of Château Paveil de Luze
BORDEAUX

Château Paveil de Luze is one of the oldest properties in the Médoc and has been with the De Luze family since 1862. Six generations managed the estate, among them, the late Frédéric de Luze was co-founder of L.D.Vins and President of Alliance des Crus Bourgeois.

Petit Paveil is a Bordeaux rouge vinified and aged at the Château, it is a fruity wine, with a lot of freshness, supple with fine okay notes for an immediate pleasure.

WINEMAKING: Traditional Vinification. Alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel vatts under modern temperature control

AGEING: 8 months in french oak (50% new wood)

FOOD & WINE PAIRING: Tapas, meat skewers, grilled meats and charcuterie
