Château Paveil de Luze is one of the oldest properties in the Médoc. The vineyard dates from the 17th century and is run by Barons de Luze Family since 1862. Today, Frédéric de Luze represents the sixth generation and continues to elaborate fine and delicate wines.

THE ESTATE

VINEYARD : 32 hectares

SOIL : Gravelly soil and subsoil

AVERAGE AGE OF THE VINES : 28 years

GRAPE VARIETIES : 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot

WINEMAKING : Thermo-regulated stainless steel vats

AGEING : 12 months in french oak barrels (30% renewed each year)
